Master of Social Sciences in Clinical Psychology

The programme extends over two years full-time. It is designed to train professional clinical psychologists in serving the community. Graduates will be equipped with the requisite knowledge and skills to become competent scientist-practitioners in the clinical psychology profession. Training components of the programme involve coursework, research dissertation, and practicum in various placement settings. Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree with honours in psychology or its equivalent.

Master of Social Sciences in Educational Psychology

The programme extends over two years full-time and provides professional training in educational psychology. It comprises coursework, supervised practical training and thesis. Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree with honours in psychology or its equivalent, preferably with at least two years of relevant experience with children or youth.

Master of Social Sciences in Psychology

The programme extends over one year full-time or two years part-time. It provides university graduates in fields other than psychology with an opportunity to acquire a solid foundation in psychology through eight courses and an individual research dissertation. It is designed to bring students to a level where they qualify for graduate membership or the Hong Kong Psychological Society, and become eligible to apply for programmes leading to the degrees of M.Soc.Sc. in Clinical Psychology and in Educational Psychology, as well as the research postgraduate degrees in psychology.

Doctor of Psychology (Clinical Psychology)

The programme extends over two years full-time or three-year part-time. It integrates a strong research focus, coherent coursework, and clinical specialty training. It prepares graduates to lead clinical and research development in the field by translating research into evidence-based clinical decisions. It integrates research, coursework and clinical specialty training. It aims to train psychologists who will be expert researchers and clinical specialists. Graduates are expected to lead clinical and research development in the profession, and bridge applied research findings with evidence-based clinical practice. Applicants must hold a Master's degree in the field of Clinical Psychology, or equivalent.
