- Second year undergraduate students or above (Psychology major)
- A good command of written and spoken Cantonese

- Have experience working with children
- Available to attend a full day training session in early to late April.

The applicants must be available for at least <u>2 half days per week from late</u> <u>April till late July 2024</u>, and fulfill the requirements listed above.
